## CAMPUS HOUSING

Reservations include both Friday and Saturday nights. Pricing is based per person reserving a twin bed package. The twin bed package includes use of one twin bed with sheets, pillow, light blanket, bath towel, and face cloth.

Standard dorm rooms are furnished with one twin bed, however a second twin bed may be added in some larger dorm locations. It is recommended that each adult in your party reserve a twin bed package.
