**Deborah S. Davis** is Professor of Sociology at Yale University specializing in the study of contemporary Chinese society. Using materials from fieldwork in China, she is currently completing two research projects, one focused on the social and political consequences of privatizing urban housing and one on poverty, wealth, and social stratification. Prof. Davis' books include: *Urban Spaces in Contemporary China*, *The Consumer Revolution in Urban China*, and *SARS: Reception and Interpretations in Three Chinese Cities*. She received a MA in East Asian Studies from Harvard and a Ph.D. in sociology from Boston University. She has been Chair of the Department of Sociology and Head of the Council of East Asian Studies at Yale.
