

Xiangming Chen (Ph.D. Duke) is founding Dean and Director of the Center for Urban and Global Studies and Paul E. Raether Distinguished Professor of Sociology and International Studies at Trinity College in Hartford, Connecticut, as well as Distinguished Professor in the School of Social Development and Public Policy at Fudan University in Shanghai, China. He also is an Honorary Research Fellow at the Institute of Economics and Center for Urban and Regional Studies of the Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences, and affiliated with the Center for East Asian Studies at the University of Chicago. He has received fellowships and grants from the American Council of Learned Societies, the American Sociological Association, the Chiang Ching-kuo Foundation for International Exchange, and the Open Society Institute. He has been conducting comparative and transnational research on the multiple facets of global-local relations in the urban and regional contexts of China and Asia. With Anthony Orum, he co-authored *The World of Cities: Places in Comparative and Historical Perspective* (Blackwell Publishers, 2003; Chinese edition from the Century Publishing Group and the People's Press of Shanghai, 2005). He is the author of *As Borders Bend: Transnational Spaces on the Pacific Rim* (Rowman & Littlefield, 2005). This book was a finalist for the Association of Borderland Studies Book Award, 2007, and on the long list for the International Convention of Asia Scholars Social Sciences Book Award, 2007. His edited book *Shanghai Rising: State Power and Local Transformations in a Global Megacity* will be forthcoming from the University of Minnesota Press in summer 2009. His articles have appeared in major urban studies and international social science journals such as *Urban Affairs Review*, *Urban Studies*, *International Journal of Urban and Regional Research*, *Cities*, *Environment and Planning A*, *International Journal of Comparative Sociology*, *Studies in Comparative International Development*, *International Journal of Organizational Analysis*, *Internationale Politik*, *Social Problems*, *Policy Sciences*, *Asian Survey*, *China Information*, and over a dozen edited books. Xiangming Chen is currently serving on the editorial board of the journal *City & Community*, the board of trustees of the Alfred Herrhausen Society, the International Forum of Deutsche Bank, and the advisory board of the Urban Age project based at the London School of Economics. He has served as President of the North American Chinese Sociologists Association and on the Council for the Community and Urban Sociology Section of the American Sociological Association. He served as Assistant to Full Professor of Sociology and Adjunct Professor of Political Science and Urban Planning and Policy at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) from 1989 to 2007 during which he also directed the International Studies, Asian Studies, and Sociology graduate programs at UIC.

陈向明持美国杜克大学(Duke University)社会学博士, 现任美国康州三一学院都市与全球研究中心首任教务长,主任,并任该学院 Paul E. Raether 社会学与国际研究讲座教授, 中国上海复旦大学社会发展与公共政策学院特聘讲座教授, 及上海社会科学院经济研究所和城市区域研究中心特聘研究员。曾先后获得美国学术社会委员会(ACLS), 美国社会学学会(ASA), 开放社会研究所, 哈佛大学等机构的奖励及资助。他近年来主要用比较与跨国的视角和方法对全球化, 亚洲和中国城市及区域特别是上海市及周边地区发展进行研究。专著有: **国界的扭曲: 太平洋圈上的跨国空间** (美国 Rowman & Littlefield 出版商 2005 年出版), **城市的世界: 比较和历史视野下的空间** (与 Anthony M. Orum 合著, 英国 Blackwell 出版商 2003 年出版, 2005 年上海世纪出版集团和人民出版社中译版), **世界城市: 国际经验与上海发展** (与周振华和黄建富合编, 上海社会科学院出版社 2004 年出版)。他编著的 **上海的崛起** 将由美国明尼苏达州大学出版社于 2009 年夏季出版。他在主要国际社会科学杂志, 城市研究杂志, 中国研究杂志上及编著中发表了几十篇学术论文。陈向明教授现任美国 **城市与社区** (*City & Community*) 杂志编委会成员, 德意志银行国际论坛 Alfred Herrhausen Society 董事会成员, 和伦敦经济学院 **Urban Age** 项目顾问委员会成员。陈向明教授曾当选为北美华裔社会学家学会主席和美国社会学学会(ASA)社区与都市分会理事。陈向明在 1989-2007 年间任美国伊利诺州大学社会学助理教授, 副教授, 及正教授。
