



## **APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL DIRECT UNSUBSIDIZED LOAN**

The terms of an Unsubsidized Loan are identical to the need-based subsidized loan (maximum 3% fee + variable interest rate capped at 8.25%)\*\* except that the borrower must either pay the interest during the in-school period or have the interest capitalized (added to the principal).

If you are interested in applying for an Unsubsidized Loan you must:

1. File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Be sure to list Trinity's code number **001414** on the application.
2. Complete the application form on the reverse side of this notice in its entirety and submit it to our office at the address below.

\*After receiving both this application form and the processed FAFSA, you will be notified when your promissory note is ready to be signed. If you had a federal Direct Subsidized or Unsubsidized Loan through Trinity College in a previous year, you will not be required to sign a new promissory note because your master promissory note will cover this loan.
