The 2010 North American Meeting of the International Society for Ecological Psychology will be held at Illinois State University in Normal, Illinois on Friday July 2 and Saturday July 3, 2010.

Call for abstracts and submission process

Submissions are currently being accepted for:

1. **Symposia (consisting of three or four 15-minute talks)**
2. **Open Forum Talks (single 15-minute talks)**
3. **Posters**



All submissions should be sent as attached word documents to Jeffrey Wagman (jbwagma@ilstu.edu). The title of the word document should include the last name of the contact person and the type of submission (e.g., "Wagman_OpenForumTalk.doc")

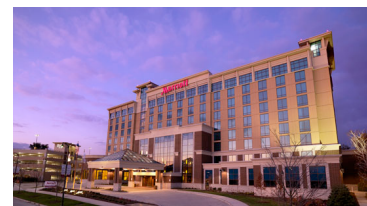
Submissions for symposia should include the title of the proposed symposium, the name(s) of the organizer(s) of the proposed symposium, a 150-word abstract of the symposium topic, the names of the presenters, and the titles of the individual presentations.

Submissions for both open forum talks and posters should include the name(s) of the presenter(s), the title of the presentation, and a 150-word abstract of the presentation.

The deadline for abstract submission is March 1, 2010.

Venue and Accommodations

The conference will be held in the Bloomington-Normal Marriott Hotel and Conference Center (201 Broadway Ave., Normal, IL 61761) (<http://www.marriottnormal.com>)



It is recommended that attendees stay at the Marriott and plan to arrive on Thursday July 1 (in time for the opening reception) and depart on Sunday July 4. A limited number of rooms will be available at a conference rate (\$119 per night — enter group code "IEPIEPA" when making online reservations). Reservations must be made by June 10 to receive this rate. A breakfast is available for an additional \$10 charge per day. If you are unable to book a room at the conference rate, email Jeffrey Wagman (jbwagma@ilstu.edu). He will then contact the hotel to see if additional rooms can be made available at this rate. The hotel also offers other discounted rates including AAA.

Student housing will be available at a residence hall on the Illinois State University campus. The cost will be approximately \$30 per person for a single (\$40 with linen service) and approximately \$20 per person for a double (\$30 with linen service). Travel to and from Bloomington-Normal

By car: Bloomington-Normal is located in central Illinois at the intersection of I-55 and I-74. It is approximately 130 miles from Chicago, 170 miles from both St. Louis and Indianapolis, and about 300 miles from Cincinnati. Free parking is available in the Marriott parking garage for hotel guests.

By plane: Central Illinois Regional Airport (airport code BMI) is approximately 5 miles from the conference site. It is possible to fly into and out of Bloomington via Atlanta, Chicago, Dallas, and Detroit.

By train: An Amtrak station is located walking distance from the conference site

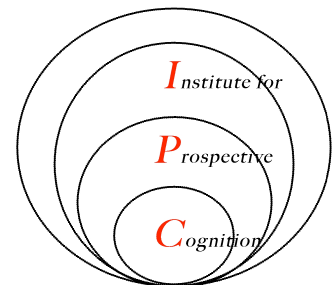
