<i>(Bi-)Annual Surveys</i>			
Admitted Student Questionnaire (ASQ)	1993-2003, 2005, 2007, 2009	Admitted students	Previously annual, now odd-numbered years', survey which focuses on impressions of Trinity, compared to their two principal alternative schools, and indicates whether the admitted student chose to attend Trinity or not. Cooperative Institutional Research Program (CIRP)	1977-	First year students	Annual survey administered in their first week at college, focusing on academic orientations, lifestyles, political views, and so forth. Managed by the Higher Education Research Institute (HERI): http://www.gseis.ucla.edu/heri/cirp.htm
Recent Graduates	2007-	Grads, two years out	An annual survey of Trinity alumni two years after graduation.
<i>Surveys of Enrolled Students</i>			
Quality of Life Survey/PULSE	1996, 97, 00, 02, 04, 05, 06, 08	All four years	An indigenous survey focusing on satisfaction with different aspects of Trinity College and their collegiate experience. Conducted in years in which we do not participate in a COFHE senior or undergraduate survey (see below). From 2008 on we will be using a consortial instrument called PULSE for this purpose instead.
COFHE Senior Survey	1990, 1994, 1998, 2002, 2006	Seniors	A survey focusing on satisfaction with different aspects of Trinity College and their collegiate experience. Fielded jointly with a number of other Consortium on Financing Higher Education (COFHE) schools. Done every four years.
COFHE Enrolled Student Surveys (ESS)	1999, 2003, 2007	All four years	COFHE periodically conducts a joint survey of undergraduates. In 1999 the Cycles survey from the Five Colleges was used, and in 2003 we used the enrolled student survey, a COFHE-designed survey of student engagement similar to the CSEQ.
Current Student Experiences Survey (CSEQ)	2001	All four years	A survey focusing on the collegiate experience. Managed by the Center for Postsecondary Research & Planning at Indiana University Bloomington, and fielded jointly with other COFHE schools. http://www.indiana.edu/~cseq/
Withdrawal Survey	1994-	Most students who voluntarily withdraw	A survey that asks about satisfaction with a dozen dimensions of Trinity experience.
Surveys of Student Alcohol and Drug Use and Attitudes	1998, 2000, 2002, 2005, 2008	All students	In 1998 we fielded the national CORE instrument, but have used our own adapted "Risky Behaviors" instrument since 2000
Survey of Students of Color	2003	All students of color	A survey of the students of color concerning campus climate at 19 schools conducted as part of the Consortium on High Achievement and Success.
