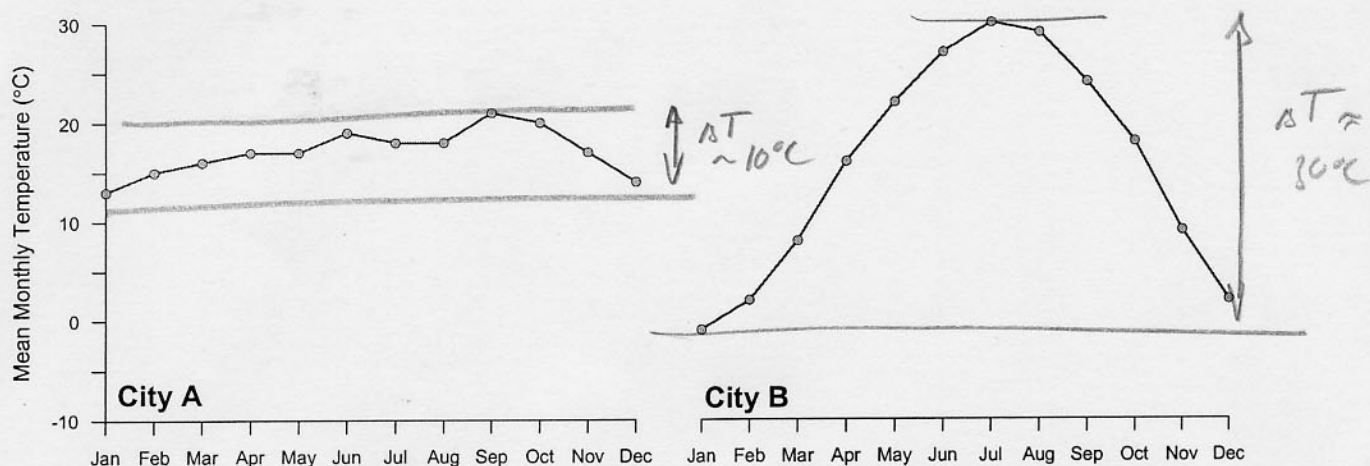


Your Name: Thasler Key



The figure above shows the average monthly temperatures for two cities in the United States of America. The two cities are at approximately the same latitude. How can you explain the observed temperature variations?

City B has much more extreme temp. fluctuations between summer (hot) and winter (really cold), which suggests a mid-continental location. City A shows little variability in temperature through the year and is likely under the moderating influence of the ocean.
