ENROLLMENT PROCESS

In order to confirm your intention to enroll at Trinity and reserve your place in the Class of 2026, you must complete the online enrollment process by February 28, 2022. A \$500 enrollment deposit may be paid online or by check payable to the Trustees of Trinity College. Please note that the deposit is nonrefundable and will be applied to your first-semester bill. FINAL GRADE REPORT
