Food N Stuff

Food N Stuff is Trinity's student food and hygiene product pantry available to all students for free. It is located on the lower level of Mather next to the main stairwell. Food N Stuff is a collaboration between the Sustainability Office, the Office of Community Service and Civic Engagement, the Bantam Network, P.R.I.D.E., WGRAC, and the Office of International Students and Scholars.

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Sustainability

Trinity College's strategic plan calls for us to build on Trinity's historic past to ensure a vibrant, sustainable future. As part of that goal, the Office of Alumni Relations collaborated with the College's sustainability coordinator to incorporate aspects of the College's Sustainability Action Plan throughout the weekend.
