Research Project

Presentations should include the follow elements:

- Why you chose the project
- A research question and hypothesis
- A summary of your literature review - What articles, books or theories did you use to guide your research? How does your research fit with, expand on, or challenge the literature on the topic?
- Methodology - How you executed the research
- Your findings - The relationship of findings to literature, the limitations of your findings
- Prospects for future research questions

Each presentation should be about 20-25 minutes with time for questions after.

Engagement Project

Presentations should include the follow elements:

- Why you chose the project
- Any relevant background information about the country/ region/ town you conducted your project in
- The partners you worked with and their missions
- Your anticipated outcomes
- How you prepared for the project
- How you executed the project
- The project outcomes and how they were similar or different from your expectations
- Challenges you faced

Each presentation should be about 20-25 minutes with time for questions after.
