- **Eric Galm**, associate professor of music, was awarded a research grant from the **Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation** to support his project, “Musical Traditions of the Minerior and Today’s Youth.”
- **Jen Jack Giesecking**, assistant professor of American studies, will contribute his expertise in digital research methods, analytics, and open access publications to a collaborative research project supported by a \$2.3 million CAD **Social Science Research Council** grant, titled “Urbanization, Gender, and the Global South: a Transformative Urban Knowledge Network.”
