Position description:

The Greenberg Center for the Study of Religion in Public Life aims to educate the Trinity and Hartford communities, as well as the broader public, about the role of religion in public life from an academic perspective through research and events.

Each year, several Trinity undergraduates serve the Center's Undergraduate Fellows over the course of the academic year. Fellows' responsibilities include the following:

- Researching a specific project on the role of religion in public life throughout the year and sharing a public-facing component of the research at the end of the academic year
- Attending weekly meetings with other fellows and Center staff to build community and share research progress
- Attending all Greenberg Center events
- Participating in the life of the Center

Fellows will be paid \$17-17.60/hr for about 5 hours of work/week. We are looking for students who have strong research and organizational skills and an interest in religion, public life, and/or their intersection.

Please answer each of the following prompts in at least a substantive paragraph, citing concrete examples.

Why are you interested in studying religion and public life as an undergraduate fellow at the Greenberg Center, given the responsibilities detailed above? What specifically brought you to your interest?

Please describe a potential public-facing research project you could imagine working on next year. You can change this if you are selected, but it would be helpful to have an idea of what you are thinking. Past projects have included partnerships with local nonprofits and story maps of the Center's archival materials.

What experience would you bring to the fellowship and the Center? How have your experiences prepared you for this role?
