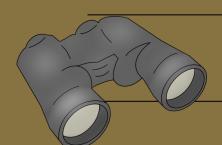


Safari Attire



- Your clothes should be comfortable, made of breathable materials, preferably light and one that you are not afraid to get dirty. We recomend wearing layers such as short sleeve shirts with a jacket that can be worn or taken off. A hoodie or longsleeve shirt that is easy to remove is a good option as well. Mornings and nights are cool so long pants that can be unfasted at the knees or light pants that are loose and airy are a great option.
- The color scheme of your clothing is very important, you need to blend in with the environment, so avoid white and bright colors. It's best to opt for nuetral tones such as khaki, beige, green and brown colors. Blue and black colors attract tsetse flies, so its better to refrain from wearing those colors in the bush or savanna.
- Shoes while on safari are also an important choice. We recommend bringing both walking sandals, and full covered boots or hiking shoes. Open toe shoes or flipflops should not be worn while on safari. While it can get hot while out in the bush, closed shoes are best to ensure safety from thorns and any bacteria issues from animal excrement. Boots or closed shoes such as hiking shoes are best to wear.
- Accessories are very important. You will spend the whole day in the African sun, so you need to take care of your health rather than your appearance. Sun hats, sunglasses, sunscreen, a bandana or mask for the dust and unscented bug spray are recommended. Fashion jewelry is not recommended to wear. While on safari absolutely NO perfume or strong scented deodorant is permitted.
- Children and minors are always welcome on safari. We recommend the same attire options for children. If your child is under the age of 12 we suggest bringing an extra change of clothes for accidents if necessary. Please keep in mind some toilet access in some parks may be a "loo with a view" so disposable wipes are recomended if applicable.
