1. Personal Information:

2. Quest Positions: The leadership needs of Quest vary year to year. Leadership position selection will be determined based on several factors. The Quest director will ultimately decide which position you may receive based on the needs of the program.

3. Leadership and Organizational Experience:

Please include the names and contact information for two references. Include the context in which the reference knows you, their title, phone number, and email address. One reference must be a faculty or administrative staff member of Trinity College. The other reference can be of your choosing but should be able to attest to you and your skills as a potential Quest Leader, do not pick other students to act as your reference.

5. Cover Letter

Respond to each question below using a cover letter format. If you do not know how to format a cover letter, please visit the Career and Life Design Center to learn how to do so.

- a. Why are you interested in becoming a member of the Quest Leadership team and how will you facilitate positive impressions about Trinity for your participants?
- b. Think of a leader (Quest member or other) that you admire. What traits does this person possess that make them an effective leader? What type of leader do you want to be?

- c. What are two positive leadership attributes that you will bring to the Quest community? How will you use these attributes help our first-year students transition to Trinity?
- d. Tell us about a time when you were challenged in a leadership role. How did you respond to this challenge and what have you learned about yourself from this experience (this can be from any leadership role that you have held)?
- e. What is one leadership quality you hope to gain as a Quest leader? How can Quest help you achieve this goal?

6. Availability:

Please indicate all dates and times that you are available for two; half-hour interviews. These interviews will start taking place February 1st and March 1st. One interview will be with two Quest Trainers/Logistics Coordinator, and the other will be with the Quest director.
